OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Request from Gulbarga Airport Developers Pvt. Ltd. and Shimoga Airport Developers Pvt. Ltd. for NOC for development of Gulbarga and Shimoga airports, Karnataka.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that comments of this Ministry were forwarded to Ministry of Civil Aviation vide MoD OM of even number dated 8th April 2008. This issue came up for discussion in the first meeting of the Steering Committee held on 15th June 2008. 'In principle' approval of the Steering Committee was granted to set up airports at Gulbarga, Bijapur, Hassan and Shimoga subject to the condition that SOP would be finalized between DGCA, AAI and Ministry of Defence regarding air space management for the airports at Gulbarga and Bijapur in view of the existing defence operations at Pune and Bidar.

2. It is reiterated that this Ministry has no objection to the proposed airport at Shimoga subject to the conditions specified in MoD letter of even no. dated 8th April 2008. So far as the proposed airport at Gulbarga is concerned, a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for airspace management between AAI and IAF needs to be formulated as decided by the Steering Committee. Since the Air Traffic Service (ATS) at the proposed airport would be provided by AAI, they may be requested to forward a draft SOP on airspace management to Air HQ. Final recommendations/ comments on the proposed airport at Gulbarga would be forwarded on finalization of SOP between AAI and IAF.
